- a. F & P (Fountas & Pinnell) literacy assessments are being conducted through September 26th, although some have already been completed. All assessments are individually administered.
- b. FAST (Formative Assessment System for Teachers) is also being administered through September 28 or has already been completed. K & grade 1 assessments are individually administered, whereas, grades 2-5 are group administered on student devices.
- c. To begin the year all classes are participating in launches which teach the process and procedures for each workshop.
- d. We are also continuing our focus on Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) with daily opening and closing circles, as well as, hour-long Wednesday SEL lessons.
