- 7.01 2016-2017 School Calendar Updates
- a. Math Night is Thursday, January 19 from 6:00-7:30 p.m.
- b. Kevin Luthardt Author Night is Monday, January 23 from 6:00-7:30 p.m.
- c. Parent Conferences & the PTO Book Fair are scheduled for Wednesday & Thursday February 15th and 16th. Conference and Book Fair hours are 3:45-7:45 on Wednesday and from 12-3 and 4-8 on Thursday. Wednesday is a full day of school. There is no student attendance from Thursday through Monday. School will resume on Tuesday, February 21.
- d. Thursday, February 23 is kindergarten and new student registration from 5:00-8:00 p.m.
- e. The fifth grade musical is Wednesday, March 8 with a dress rehearsal at 1:00 p.m. and two evening performances. A note will be going home soon to all fourth and fifth graders about the evening performances.
- f. Our "Snow Better Time to Read" Celebration will be Friday, January 27 and a note will be sent home tomorrow.

## 7.02 Instruction Updates

- a. FAST (Formative Assessment System for Teachers) tests are currently being administered to kindergarteners through fifth graders this week and next week
- b. ACCESS (<u>Assessing Comprehension and Communication in English State-to-State for English Language Learners</u>) testing is ongoing from now through mid February for our bilingual students.
- c. NAEP (National Assessment of Educational Progress) will be administered to fourth grade students on Tuesday, January 31. It is administered once every four years to fourth and eighth graders. Information will be sent home next week explaining the test. Students will be assessed one of the following ways: math paper pencil, math on a tablet, reading paper and pencil or reading on a tablet. Students will only take one format of the assessment in one subject area. This is the first time NAEP is conducting the assessments utilizing technology. The results are referred to as the "Nation's Report Card".
- d. Our teachers continue to use their professional learning time Wednesday afternoons to improve their professional practice. Some of our recent and future topics included: assessing reading levels without formal benchmarking, learning about our new science learning experiences, MTSS (Multi-Tiered Systems of Support) among others.

#### 7.03 General Comments
